

This ain't your daddy's flamenco. Where previous generations of flamenco players took their influences from first the classical & later the jazz worlds, the new crew has grown up on the Beatles & Led Zeppelin and bring that into their styles. These discs rock with gabriela, a rarity as a female flamenco player, holding down the rhythm end for the most part & rodrigo taking the leads. Their version of "Stairway To Heaven" alone is worth having the disc but the other tunes take you on various trips. The additional dvd is a nice touch. Very well recorded with the guitars sounding especially crisp. it's a good listen.
